Pennsylvania's leading logger training and forest landowner outreach program is seeking an energetic self-starter to lead and manage the program into the next decade.

The Sustainable Forestry Initiative, Inc. (SFI) Program Manager serves as the face of the SFI program in Pennsylvania, representing and promoting the program to various stakeholder groups and the general public. Primary responsibilities include coordinating and conducting logger training programs; maintaining accurate records for logger training participants; implementing landowner outreach activities; and securing the financial support from industry and other entities.

The SFI Program Manager must be self-motivated and demonstrate the ability to operate independently. The Program Manager will report to the SFI State Implementation Committee. The position requires some in-state travel, including occasional overnight travel.

Preferred candidates will have strong oral presentation and written communication skills, organizational skills, the ability to multi-task and a desire to educate others. A degree or experience in forestry, natural resources, logging or wood products is desired.

The PA Sustainable Forestry Initiative State Implementation Committee is a non-board committee of the Pennsylvania Forest Products Association and the Program Manager is an employee of PFPA.

This is a full-time salaried position with benefits. Compensation will be based on background/experience. Applicants will be accepted until position filled, with interviews beginning in February.
